# How To Celebrate Constitution Day On November 26

Dear educator,

You may be aware of that the government has announced the celebration of November 26 as the "Constitution Day." On this day in 1949, 35 crore people, who were subjects in their respective 562 kingdoms, became citizens and stakeholders of the sovereign India. This was the most significant moment in the history of this country so far as peoples' empowerment was concerned.

Civil society Build India Group had been urging the Government of India since 2012 to celebrate this day as the "Citizens' Day" to inculcate in each and every Indian a sense of belonging to the country.

Keeping in view the experience of Pledge Festival for the last eight years, the organisation has visualised a simple, inexpensive and doable pan-India exercise in 16 Indian languages. We hope that your esteemed educational institution will immensely benefit out of it.

The proposal is as under:

Select the pledge in your mother tongue and add three lines "We reject violence in any form. We promise to keep our environment clean and tidy. We promise to be good citizens and, therefore, we are taking this solemn pledge" on the top in the selected language. At the bottom of the document, space should be left for signatures of student and parents. This should be the homework prior to November 26.

On November 26, all students should bring this document to the educational institution. They should be motivated about the idea of India, constitution, preamble. And finally the pledge should be recited in unison exactly at 10.20 am. After rendition of the pledge, all students are to sign the solemn document and present the same with the institution authority. You may organise cultural activities i.e. drama, dance or songs on nationalism as the theme under the banner Pledge Festival to charge up the ambiance. Earlier Pledge Festival was being celebrated in over 1000 educational institutions across the country on the third Saturday of January every year. We consider you as a valued partner in this mission and wish that you share this idea with your neighbouring educational institutions so that they could also benefit from this programme.
